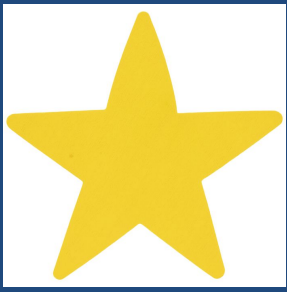

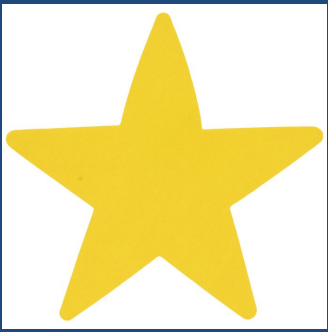
School-Wide Expectations

What is a value?

Haven Core Values



CORE VALUES	DEFINITION
S afe	Protected from danger or damage.
T imely	Done or completed sufficiently early or prompt.
A ware	Having knowledge or perception of what is going on in one's surroundings.
R espectful	A feeling of deep admiration for someone or something elicited by their abilities, qualities or achievements.
S uccessful	Accomplishing an aim or purpose.

Our core values are easy to remember! They spell out STARS< like Northstars.

I am Respectful

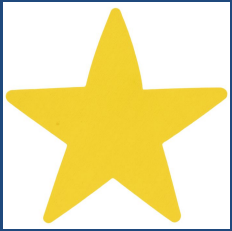
- ★ I actively listen and participate.

February: Focus of **T**IMELY

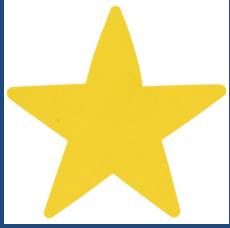
March: Focus of **A**WARE

Lunch - Tri. 2 Assigned Seats

- Lunch is a time for eating and socializing with your peers.
- Lunch is also a time when you are unmasked.
- This is not a consequence, but a measure to ensure that we are safe and can perform effective contact tracing if necessary.

A few non-negotiable expectation reminders:

- 1) You may not have your cell phone out or use it at any point during the day. It will be confiscated and a parent/guardian will need to pick it up.
- 2) Your mask is worn effectively over your nose and mouth at all times (exception of lunch [while eating] and outdoor recess)
- 3) You must be to class on time. We have extended the passing period to accommodate you.
- 4) If you are in the hallway you must have a pass from your teacher.
- 5) You must attend your assigned lunch/recess period.
