DAILY STUDENT SELF CERTIFICATION PROCESS

As part of our safety measures for in-person learning, we will use a web-based system to manage our student health self-certification process called CrisisGo Safety iPass. Self Certifications are used to monitor symptoms of illness and potential exposure to COVID-19. This is a critical step in keeping our school communities safe and is very important to preventing the spread of COVID-19.

HEALTH SELF CERTIFICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED DAILY FOR EACH CHILD RETURNING IN-PERSON

The **simple, three-step process** will take two minutes or less per child. This process is required to be completed daily:

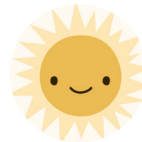
1. Take your child's temperature. Students with a temperature of 100.4 or greater must stay home.
2. Complete the brief self-certification form for each child.
3. Follow any next steps as indicated by the color badge received upon completion.



Download the free 'CrisisGo' mobile app! Data rates apply. Health Self Certification forms can be completed via the app by clicking on the 'iPass' option at the bottom. The form can be completed in multiple languages and collects only essential information related to COVID-19.



The system is user friendly and can be accessed on any computer, smartphone, or tablet.



Build into your morning routine! Make sure to complete prior to leaving for school.



Daily email reminders will be sent each morning at 6am.



Staff members will be checking for completion of health certifications upon arrival!
