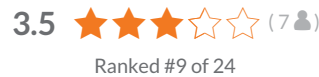
Evanston as a whole we also love our King Arts community and love that we have connections to friends all over Evanston and not just in our own neighborhood.



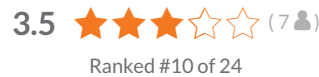
I relate to the neighborhood embraced by Chute, Dawes and Washington Schools, which I walk often. James Park and the Levy Center and new Robert Crown



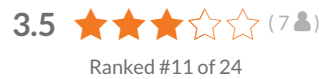

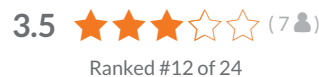

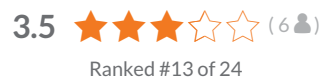
I live in the 9 ward and feel connected with skevanston and downtown Evanston



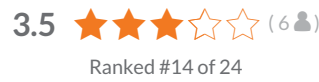
My community is not defined by space or place or location but in shared ideals and dreams and goals for our children Location and place tend to be racially and economically homogenous



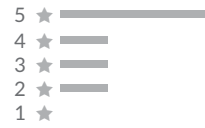
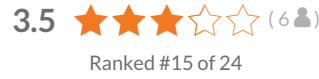

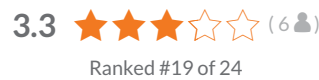
people who I see regularly- mostly walkable, neighbors i talk to, kids my kids play with, families at our neighborhood school frequent contact, shared experiences, mutual support



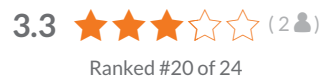
