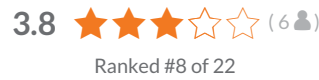
A neighborhood is compromised by relationships and connectedness. Proximity between home and school are important.



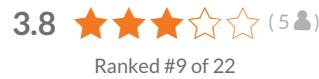
I think my students feel connected to the school and immediate area around the school, although a huge portion of our students are bused. I think our students who are bused don't necessarily have the same connection to other students.



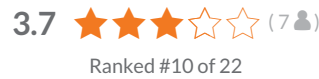
I want to walk to the playground after school



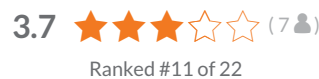

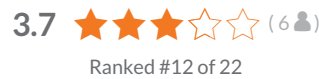

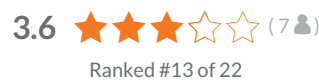
What creates a neighborhood are shared spaces. Same school, same grocery stores, parks, etc. Builds relationships with others. Makes people Feel comfortable where you are



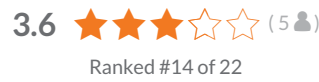

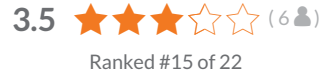

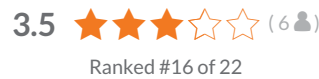
Parks, friends' houses, community centers. A lot of our students go over to Robert Crown after school



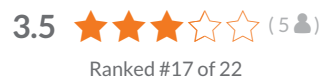

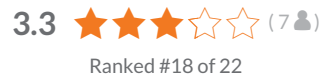

A strong home/school connection. Learning should happen everywhere!



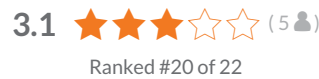
The middle schools are too far away from students' homes and there is no transportation This inhibits development of community



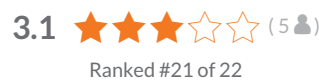
They should be able to walk to school and play with the students that attend to their school. They can also attend to a magnet
