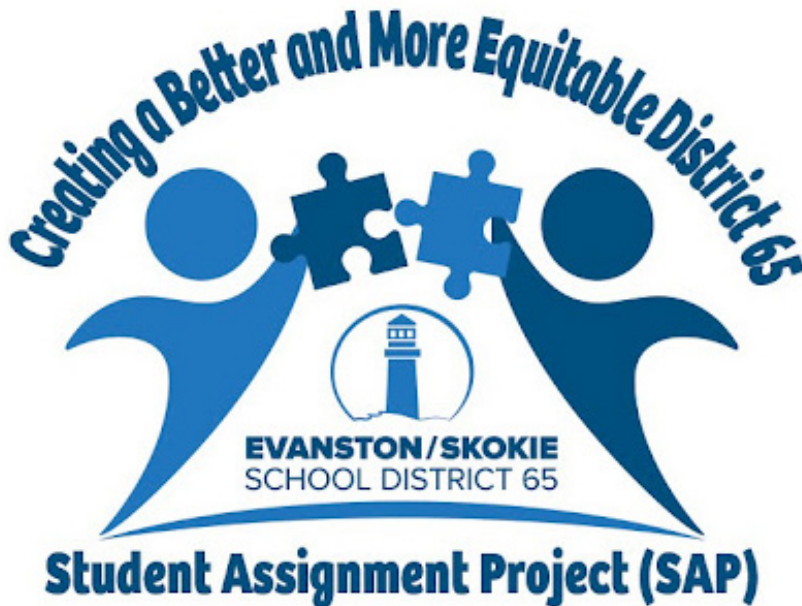


Join Us, Your Voice Matters!
