



School District 65 Fees: 2019– 2020 School Year

STUDENT AND TRANSPORTATION FEES

Student and Transportation Fees are determined by the Board of Education and are collected annually. Invoices for families with returning students are mailed in the spring. Fees for new students and incoming kindergarteners are due at the time of registration unless families are applying for free or reduced meals. All fees are waived for students qualifying for free meals.

General Student Fees

General Student Fees are used to support playground/meals supervision and classroom consumables.

General Student Fees for the 2019-2020 school year are:

- \$95 per student
- \$30 per student qualifying for reduced-price meals
- **Waived for students qualifying for free meals.**

Classroom Activity Fees

Classroom Activity Fees are used by classroom teachers to purchase such items as classroom magazine subscriptions, materials for specialized projects and classroom incentives. Classroom Activity Fees for the 2019-2020 school year are:

- \$35 for students in grades K - 5
- \$12 for students in grades K - 5 qualifying for reduced-price meals
- \$45 for students in grades 6 - 8
- \$15 for students in grades 6 - 8 qualifying for reduced-price meals
- **Waived for students qualifying for free meals.**

Technology Fee

Technology Fees will be used to partially offset the growing cost of instructional technology. Technology Fees for the 2019-2020 school year are:

- \$40 for students in grades K - 8
- \$12 for students qualifying for reduced-price meals
- **Waived for students qualifying for free meals.**

Transportation Fees

Students enrolled in a magnet school or special program (African Centered Curriculum (ACC) or Two-Way Immersion-English (TWE)) may be eligible for transportation. 2019-2020 transportation fees per student are:

- \$529 full fee for students in grades K - 8
- \$158 for students qualifying for reduced-price meals
- **Waived for students qualifying for free meals.**

Late Fee

A late fee of \$20 per student will be assessed if fees are paid after 9/28/2019 or 30 days after registration date, if registered after the start of school.

Families who are not eligible for free or reduced meals but who cannot pay the fee because of special circumstances may apply for a payment plan or they may request an administrative waiver through the Business Office 847-859-8040.

OTHER FEES

Participation Fees

Participation fees are collected as needed and include such items as:

- Camp Timber-Lee (grade 5)
- P.E. uniforms (grades 6-8)
- Graduation fees for 8th graders (cap/gown, parties)
- Field Trips

Scholarships may be provided by schools for some participation fees.

Personal Supply List

Families are provided a personal supply list for items they are expected to purchase. Items on the supply list may include: assignment notebook, binders, notebooks, notebook paper, pens, pencils, crayons, markers, ruler, compass, calculator, tissue, etc. Basic school supplies for eligible families may be available through programs at your child's school.
