Educators worked tirelessly to prepare for the beginning of the year to create a positive and supportive environment for our students whether on-site or remotely. Remember that our calendar has changed and all Mondays are ½ days of Remote Instruction. Monday's will consist of a blend of synchronous student learning and engagement and educator professional learning in the afternoon. Asynchronous learning activities will be provided by educators for the afternoon.
